Hit the road with us! Our Table Cooperative is looking for a part-time seasonal Delivery Driver to bring our farm-fresh products to Portland-area restaurants, retailers, and customers. Friday shifts available now through Oct (8 hours, early start) plus Tuesday shifts during our busy summer season (mid-June through mid-August). No CDL required, but a clean driving record is a must—we prefer drivers 25 or older. About Our Table Cooperative

Located in Sherwood, Oregon—just 15 miles south of Portland—Our Table Cooperative is a 58-acre organic farm and worker-owned cooperative. We grow a wide variety of vegetables, fruit, eggs, and meats and source additional products from Oregon farmers and food artisans who share our values. Our on-farm grocery store and commercial kitchen are at the heart of what we do, and we're proud to offer our community a direct connection to the land and the people who tend it.

The Role

We are looking for a dependable, safety-conscious delivery driver to help distribute Our Table's farm-fresh products to retailers, restaurants, and customers throughout the Portland area. This is a hands-on, physically active role that requires early morning availability, safe and courteous driving, and good communication with our team and delivery partners. A CDL is not required, but a clean driving record is essential.

Schedule

Fridays (now - Oct): ~8-hour shift with an early start (6:00–7:00 AM)

Tuesdays (mid-June through mid-August): 6-8-hour shift with an early start (6:00–7:00 AM).

Responsibilities

- Safely load, transport, and unload food products and related goods.
- Operate a delivery van/box truck in a safe, lawful, and courteous manner at all times.
- Follow assigned delivery schedules; maintain accurate records of pickups, deliveries, mileage, and equipment logs.
- Ensure the truck is properly loaded, product is secured and protected from damage, and the vehicle is in good working condition before each run.
- Build and maintain positive working relationships with retail partners, restaurant accounts, and customers.
- Regularly inspect and clean the vehicle, report maintenance needs to management promptly.
- Other duties as needed.

Requirements

- Valid Oregon driver's license with a clean driving record (non-negotiable)
- Age 25 or older preferred (insurance requirements).
- CDL not required; experience driving a large delivery van or box truck is a strong plus.
- Reliable early morning availability on Fridays; Tuesday availability during peak summer months (mid-June–mid-August).
- Physical ability to load and unload by hand; regularly lift up to 50 lbs.
- Ability to work outside in all weather conditions.
- Strong attention to detail, time management, and self-direction.
- Excellent interpersonal skills; comfortable representing the Co-op to customers and wholesale partners.
- Familiarity with the Portland metro area is helpful.
- A genuine interest in local food systems, organic farming, or sustainable agriculture is a plus.
