BACKGROUND

We are a cooperative of farmers, producers and consumers working together to create a community-based food system. The farm is located 15 miles south of Portland and grows a diverse mix of produce for our own on-farm grocery store and kitchen, as well as for CSA, restaurants and grocery stores in and around the greater Portland area. We grow vegetables, berries, flowers, tree-fruit and bees year-round and are looking for the right individual to join us!

JOB DESCRIPTION

We are seeking a full-time, experienced farmer to support 3 acres of no-till vegetable production beginning in April 2024 and running through October 2024. Ideal candidates are self-motivated, detail oriented, enjoy working in a group, and are motivated to streamline workflow. Vegetable farming is very physical work, but also requires a sharp mind, good judgment, and a great sense of humor. There are additional opportunities to participate in perennial growing, farm events, educational activities, and various other projects at the Cooperative.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Primary responsibilities will be working with the Farm Managers and the rest of the team on the following:
 - Harvesting and packing out vegetables for wholesale and CSA
 - Executing plantings
 - Coordinating field work with the rest of the crew
 - Seeding and greenhouse propagation
 - Delivering to wholesale accounts
- Field work will include, but not be limited to, bed preparation in no-till manner, planting, cultivating, irrigating, field maintenance, construction, composting, tractor operation
- Other duties, as necessary

- 1+ years of prior farm work with small or medium scale mixed vegetable farms
- Clean driving record
- Detail oriented and fast learner
- Self-motivated and able to streamline workflow
- Able to sustain the physical rigor of a farming season
- Positive attitude in all types of weather
- Excellent interpersonal skills and willingness to work with a diverse group of people
- Ability to keep clear handwritten and electronic records
- Strong love of food, nutrition and healthy local economies
- Experience in no-till farming a plus

- BCS and tractor experience a plus

Working Hours: Expect a seasonally flexible work week averaging 40 hours/week over the course of the season. Our typical day begins at 6.30 am and ends at 3 pm, with a 30-minute lunch break. While we strive to hold to these hours, we work in an increasingly volatile climate and reserve the right to be flexible with our start and end times.

Compensation: \$16.25/hr. Pay raise possible upon completion of six-week review.
