Our Table Cooperative is looking for a part-time prep cook to work on our farm in Sherwood. Your job will involve working with our kitchen team under the guidance of our farm chef on Friday evening happy-hour service, Saturday brunch service, and Sunday prep for our grocery store deli case. The job requires a minimum of 22 hours/week with the possibility of additional days/hours if desired. The job involves a wide range of tasks in a dynamic and ever-changing environment. If you have experience in a professional kitchen, are a self-directed and collaborative cook, and are hankering for something more meaningful, come join us as we collectively create a whole new food culture -- one that is based on authentic relationships and treats people, animals, and soil with the respect they deserve.

REQUIREMENTS

- **Ability to work Friday afternoons (1pm to 9pm); Saturdays (7am to 3pm); and Sundays (8am to 4pm).**
- **Experience in a professional kitchen is necessary.**
- Excellent and wide-ranging cooking skills. Pizza experience a plus.
- Knowledge and familiarity with seasonal variations in Pacific NW ingredients a plus.
- Creativity and entrepreneurial spirit -- a willingness to do whatever it takes.
- Willingness to work in a highly collaborative environment.
- Current Food Handlers Card.
- Excellent customer service skills.
- Ability to complete both small batch and scaled recipes.
- Must have keen ability to smell, taste, and visually inspect ingredients as well as finished product.
- Must be able to meet physical requirements of standing, twisting, bending, repetitive motion and lifting 10-40lbs regularly.
- Ability to commute to Sherwood, Oregon.

This is a part-time hourly position with a minimum of 22 hours/week starting as soon as possible.

BACKGROUND

Located in Sherwood, Oregon just 15 miles south of Portland, our 58-acre organic farm produces a large variety of organic vegetables, fruit, eggs and meats. As a farm cooperative, we source the things we don't grow on our own farm from other Oregon farmers and food artisans who share our ethics and commitment to quality. We have a commercial kitchen facility and grocery store on our farm.
